BASES FOR THE BEST POSTER AND ORAL COMMUNICATION PRIZES

Preamble

The University of Lleida, in its desire to promote research and especially among the younger members of the scientific community, convenes two prizes for the two best posters and one prize for the best oral communication presented during the "WELCOME SESSION TO PhD CANDIDATES".

Competition rules

1. Purpose: Award the two best posters and the best oral communication presented at the "WELCOME SESSION TO PhD CANDIDATES".
2. Participants: All communications presented in poster and/or oral communication format may be selected for the prizes. The author submitting the abstract must be the first author and enrolled in a Doctoral Program at the UdL.
3. Budget: Each prize will be awarded with 400€ and a diploma, which will be delivered to the first authors of the work. This amount will be subject to current taxation. In the case that there is more than one first author, the prize will be shared between them.
4. Procedure for prizes selection: A jury formed by the members of the Scientific Committee (base number 8) will select one awarded poster and the awarded oral communication, according to the established criteria. The other poster prize will be selected by vote of all the PhD candidates participating in the Welcome Session. In order to be able to vote, the PhD candidates must show an identifying document (DNI or passport in force) when casting their vote.
5. Criteria: **The rigor, the content scientific interest, the presentation, as well as the clarity and capacity for communication will be valued. It will**

also be taken into account if the poster fits the required dimensions (70cm wide and 100cm high) and if the communication meets the time slot (5 minutes).

6. Decision: The decision of the Jury will be made public at the closing ceremony and will be unappeasable. Accepting the competition rules is a requirement to participate in the competition.
7. Delivery: The prizes will be delivered at the Closing ceremony.
